8:45 a.m. Adult Bible Class *(in the church proper)*

Pastor Bugbee's Sunday class is open to everyone; no advance registration needed ... just show up, 8:45-9:40 a.m.! As requested, we're offering a few brief sessions this fall on the Christian calendar, season and colours ... and then will launch into a lengthier study of the Book of Proverbs.

10:00 a.m. Divine Service *(in the church proper)*

This gathering is the cornerstone of our life together! It's rooted in God's Word read and preached, in the prayers of the church, and in the singing of His people (through our choir and full congregation). Visitors are always welcome, even if they are "seekers" who don't yet know much of the Christian faith or don't yet confess Christ.

Holy Communion is celebrated in these services on the 1st, 3rd and 5th Sundays of any month. Baptized visitors from outside the fellowship of our churches are welcome to come forward during the distribution to receive a baptismal blessing, if they wish.

Food Bank Emphasis – 2nd Sunday of Every Month

We encourage members and friends to bring in non-perishable groceries (mostly canned and boxed items) on the second Sunday of the month. There are receptacles at both major entrances to our building plant where you can place them. Groceries are forwarded to our friends at Peace Lutheran Church, which maintains a very effective and well-run Food Bank. This is a strong way of supporting the needy in our community.

Giles Boulevard – Road Construction Fall 2025

The City of Windsor began installing new watermain on Giles Boulevard (between Ouellette and Janette) in September, 2025. This affects the area around our church, and the work is scheduled to continue through November. Members have often parked at the Firestone lot (at Ouellette and Giles), since they are not open on Sundays. Others seek to parallel park on surrounding streets. During these weeks you may want to allow a few extra minutes to find the best spot. For the handicapped, if our Giles Boulevard entrance is hard to access, you may opt for the main entrance to the church on Victoria Avenue.
